

Guidelines for Full Paper Submission:

Full papers should have a maximum page limit of **6 pages** and should adhere to the formatting guidelines prescribed below. While the papers for poster presentation should stick to the “Poster paper guidelines” mentioned below.

Full Paper Guidelines:

Papers must be submitted in PDF (Portable Document Format) and should be compatible with Acrobat (English version). They should not include any special characters or nonstandard fonts. Please ensure that your submissions can be displayed and printed, without further processing, using only standard tools and postscript printers.

Make sure that the paper prints well on black-and-white printers.

Generated PDF must have all the following characteristics:

1. Be PDF 1.4 (Acrobat 5) or later but not Acrobat 9.
2. Scanning is not permitted.
3. Embeds or subsets all fonts. Doing so helps makes sure that the mathematics appears as intended and improves text searching in the PDF. *Please note some TrueType fonts have a setting added by the font designer that prevents the font from being embedded and should be avoided.*
4. Does not have a password or other security settings.
5. Does not contain any bookmarks or links. Links are supported now **only** by using a summary.txt, readme file, and a packing list.
6. Does not contain crop marks, registration marks, date stamp, time stamp, or any other mark that does not appear in the official version of the publication.
7. Does not contain any PostScript that overrides the settings file.
8. Does not use PDF attachments.
9. Does not consist of a PDF Package or Merged PDF, a PDF 1.7 (Acrobat 8) feature.

It describes the essential steps in distilling PDFs. Please pay particular attention to figures and graphs in the paper to ensure that they are legible when printed using standard black-and-white printers.

The formatting guidelines for the submission and that for the final camera-ready version of the accepted papers are identical.

Overall Appearance:

The submitted papers should adhere to the appearance of the standard IEEE two column format that is used for IEEE Conference Proceedings. The papers should be typeset using 10pt font on US Letter paper with margins no smaller than 0.75in for the top margin, 1.0in for the bottom margin, and 0.625in for side margins.

For your convenience, the templates for typesetting with LaTeX and Microsoft Word are available. Authors are strongly encouraged to use one of the style guides given below:

For reasons of reviewing fairness, papers that exceed the page limit and/or are incorrectly formatted will not be accepted for review.

Ethics:

- Submission of papers to WMSC-2015 carries with it the implied agreement that the paper represents original work. We will follow the plagiarism policy of IEEE Communications Society. All submitted papers will be subjected to a "similarity test". Papers achieving a high similarity score will be examined and those that are deemed unacceptable will be rejected without a formal review. We also expect to report such unacceptable submissions to the superiors of each of the authors.
- Submission of papers to WMSC-2015 also carries with it the implied agreement that one or more of the listed authors will register for and attend the conference and present the paper. Papers not presented at the conference will not be included in the final program or in the digital proceedings. Therefore, authors are strongly encouraged to plan accordingly before deciding to submit a paper.

Poster Guidelines:

Preparing a well-organized, visually-pleasing poster requires good plan well in advance. First, the students need to consider their audience and type of poster they'll create. Next, they need to gather supplies and decide what information to include. From this point, they need to create the text and graphics. Remember to format the poster as follows:

- STANDARD Poster Size: 36 inches × 48 inches
- Layout Orientation: Landscape or Portrait
- Materials: Paper-based (with matte finish or coated paper)
- Key Information (include, as a minimum the following information): Title, Name, Phone, Email, University, Location, and Type of Poster: Research or Project

If poster is accepted: (a) the presenting author is required to register for the workshop, (b) bring the printed poster in the registration desk, and (c) the presenting author must attend and present the poster at the workshop.
